About Sunday Worship

The standard communion service in the Episcopal Church is divided into two halves. The first half is all about **The Word**, and the second half is all about **The Bread**. Prayers are scattered throughout the service, as are hymns.

During this pandemic, Trinity provides the stand-alone Service of the Word in the digital format, which you can find at TrinityWarsaw.org, and in the in-person format when it is safe to do so. The portion of the service understood as **The Bread** will return when it is safe once more to share communion.

The Word is focused on intellectually knowing God – reading the Bible, hearing interpretations of ancient scripture, speaking what we believe, and sharing our needs with God.

Other Helpful Information

Masks and hand sanitizer are located near the door where you came into the worship space.

The Offering Plate is located near the door where you came in for any donation or pledge you would like to offer to support the ministry of Trinity Church.

First Time Visitors are asked for pandemic purposes to immediately text Mother Sare at 716-725-8213 with their names before or after the service so they may be notified in case of emergency for contact tracing. A phone number given in such a manner will only be used for this purpose. Visitors are also invited to give the office their contact information via the form located in this worship guide.
